- · Reduces OR time and anesthesia time.
- · Avoids the need of an extra assistant for the holding the limb during scrubbing, and the awake patient can collaborate in this process.
- · Prevents skin cooling due to disinfectant evaporation.

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USER GUIDE

PrepSleeve® is a limb enclosure system with inner rough surface for effective disinfection and scrubbing in the pre-op setting .









- 1. Open the pouch and remove the sleeve.
- 2. Pour 100-150 cc of the disinfectant liquid of your choice into the sleeve (Warning: verify any allergy or hypersensitivity of the patient to the liquid before using).
- 3. Use the handles to place the PrepSleeve high on the patient's limb. Tighten the strap to secure the proximal end of the sleeve.
- 4. Rub manually for 2-4 minutes to spread the liquid over the entire limb skin surface (may repeat as needed). For effective scrubbing verify that the liquid completely coats the skin, including between the toes/fingers.
- 5. PrepSleeve can stay on the limb for the entire duration of the scrubbing procedure, according to the instructions of the disinfectant's manufacturer.





- 6. When ready, drain the liquid to the distal compartment of the sleeve and tighten the distal strap.
- 7. Once in the OR, cut the sleeve open longitudinally by peeling off the seam along the sleeve.

Lift the limb by grabbing the toes/fingers with a sterile towel; remove and discard the sleeve, and proceed with the draping. If desired, use a sterile towel to dry the limb.

Warnings:

- 1. Do not over-scrub delicate skin.
- 2. Verify allergies and hypersentivities.
- 3. When used on damaged/injured skin, some disinfectants may be irritating.
- 4. Remove promptly and rinse the skin if signs of irritation develop.
